Pickens County Sheriff's Office Arrests Shooter from Weekend Confrontation at Apartment Complex in Central

The Pickens County Sheriff's Office has taken a Chapin, SC man into custody following his arrest yesterday afternoon in Lexington County. The arrest comes from a two day investigation into the shooting of a Tri-County Tech student that was struck with a 9mm round fired from a handgun during a physical altercation between several men.

As previously released, the incident occurred at "The Cottages of Clemson" located at #202 Smoke Rise Dr just after midnight Saturday night pursuant to a large party attended by several hundred individuals.

The victim identified as Jaye Andrew Stuck (21yoa) of Pomaria, SC remains hospitalized for a gunshot wound to the neck/head area. Mr. Stuck is expected to recover from his injuries.

Jackson Quaid Rowland (21yoa) was transported late last night to Pickens County where he is currently being detained in the Pickens County Detention Facility charged with the following offenses:

Sheriff Rick Clark stated...

"On Monday, I spoke directly with a representative from the management oversight team for The Cottages of Clemson. I am very encouraged by their commitment to the safety and security of their tenants and their desire to partner with local law enforcement as we identify and implement additional security measures to minimize any opportunities for violence".

A meeting with the management oversight team along with other local law enforcement officials will be held as soon as possible to discuss proactive measures for the property managers to consider moving forward.
