Pickens County Sheriff's Office Charges Third Person following Shooting Investigation at Apartment Complex in Central

The Pickens County Sheriff's Office has taken a third person into custody following an ongoing investigation into the shooting of a Tri-County Tech student on August 28, 2016.

Jaye A. Stuck (21yoa) of Pomaria, SC is still recovering from a single gunshot wound to the neck/head area following an altercation at "The Cottages of Clemson" located at #202 Smoke Rise Dr. The incident occurred just after midnight on the last weekend in August during a large party attended by several hundred people.

Haleigh Lynn Wallace (19yoa) was arrested earlier this afternoon at the Pickens County Law Enforcement Center where she was placed into the Detention Facility charged with the following offense:

Ms. Wallace was released later in the afternoon following the posting of a \$10,000.00 Surety Bond.
