Six Mile Man Arrested following Facebook Threats of Shooting Law Enforcement

The Pickens County Sheriff's Office has arrested a man from Six Mile after he posted a warning on social media of shooting law enforcement officers in Pickens County.

The investigation was initiated Thursday, June 8, 2017, pursuant to the Sheriff's Office being notified of two postings made on a personal Facebook page earlier the same date for the public to view. Statements included the following content:

"when I get pissed off and start shooting pickens county kkkops don't say I didn't warn ya" SIC

A second posting went on to say that he hoped that "Rick Clark" would be shot.

Joey William Woodall (38yoa) was arrested without incident at a business in Pickens County late Thursday, June 8, 2017.

He was booked into the Pickens County Detention Center and immediately transferred to the Oconee County Detention Facility where he is currently detained pending transportation back to Pickens County for a bond hearing yet to be scheduled.

Woodall is charged with the following offense:
